Arthur Companies (elevator areas), the Catholic Church, Lutheran Church, ball park area (east side of town) and Dakota Agronomy (north of the tracks) have authorized use of their areas for parking. Shuttle service will be available from Dakota Agronomy. You can park anywhere else but please do not block driveways or alleys.

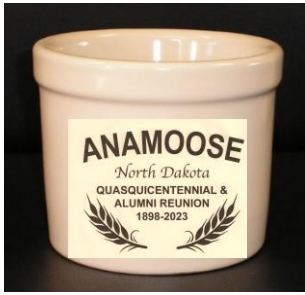

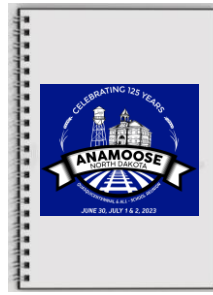

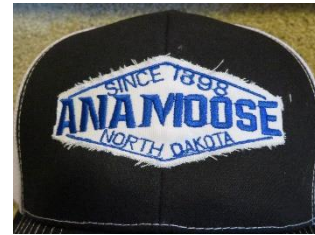
